BEAM is a hands-on summer program for high school and college students in Northern New Mexico who are curious about science, technology, engineering, and math.

During BEAM, you will:

- **Run real experiments in optics & quantum science** in small teams
- **Discover how light-based technologies work**—from lasers to fiber optics
- **Explore how light can measure, move, and encode information**
- **Build practical lab skills** that set you apart
- **Make connections** that can help you land future internships
- **Explore career paths** in cutting-edge science and technology fields

This will be a 4-week, in-person summer school.

Participants will receive a \$2,000 stipend at the end of the summer school.

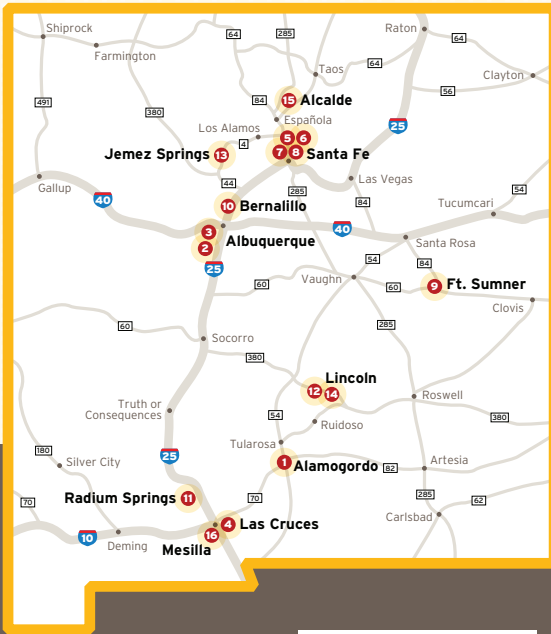
TAMAYA MTB

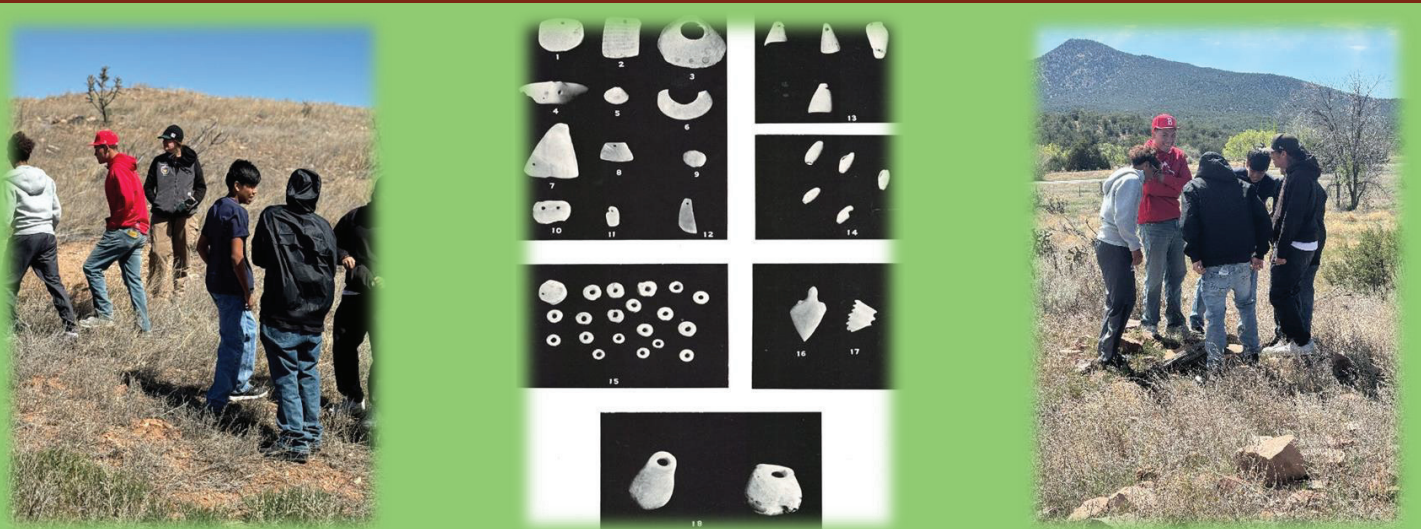

At Paa'ku, the THPO presented Tamayame migration history & Paa'ku's place within it, the history of archaeological excavations & studies of the site, examples of pottery sherds & other artifacts, what it teaches us, & how it confirms Tamayame oral history. Students were able to walk around the site, pick up artifacts, & ask questions. After braving the winds, we all enjoyed lunch together at the Pueblo Cultural Center. THPO enjoyed the time spent with students & Keres language teachers.

Everyone at risk. Minimize time spent outside as much as possible

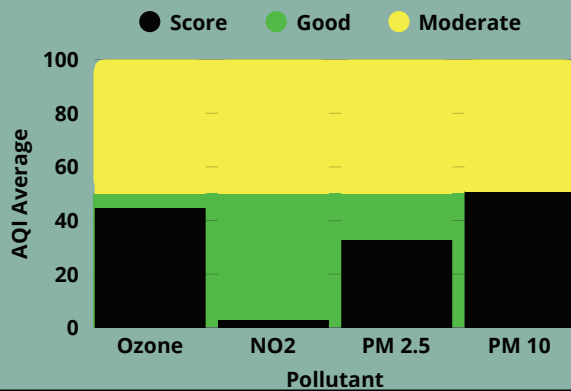


201-300

Santa Ana's Pollutant Levels



Moderate levels of air quality is acceptable for most people. Those with very sensitive or compromised lungs may be impacted.

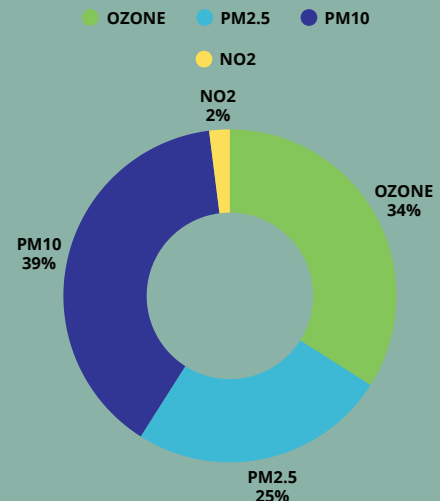
If unusually sensitive to air pollution, watch for symptoms of shortness of breath or coughing while outside.

PM 10 was the highest recorded pollutant in our air due to storms.

Intense thunderstorms cause downdrafts lifting lots of dust into the air, impacting visibility and air quality.

With monsoon season in June along with increased heat there will likely be more dust storms and higher average ozone.

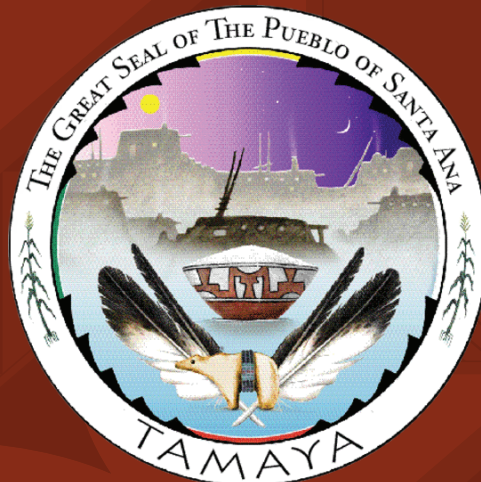
